If you want a slightly smaller-than-usual version of one of several newer Mustangs, a resin model conversion kit in 1/25th scale is available for Monogram's 1989-90 Mustang GT convertible hobby kit. This conversion kit includes the body, interior, and rear glass (plastic). You will use the chassis, engine, seats, steering wheel, and tires from the Monogram kit. Use super glue with this plastic resin kit conversion, and regular model paint works fine. The kit does not include the standard slotted cast aluminum wheels. This conversion leads to a very nice model of the LX Mustang. Cost is \$30 plus \$3 s/h, wheels are \$8.50 plus \$4 s/h. Conversions are also available for 1992 LX Hatchback and 1992 GT Hatchback models. For the kits, contact:
