## Upcoming Southern Nationals Car Show To Feature Thirty Classes, Trophies, Cash

The Ninth Annual **Southern Nationals Car Show**, an All-Ford car show and swap meet will be held Saturday, June 11, 1994 at Central Middle School in Murfreesboro, Tennessee. The show will be hosted by the Performance Ford Club of America's Central Tennessee Chapter. Sponsored by Town & Country Ford and Mark Stacey of Stacey's Concours Restorations, the show will feature over thirty classes and offer both trophies and cash prizes.

Nine of the thirty classes will apply to directly to Music City Mustangers. These are: All Bosses/Shelbys; 64-66 Open; 64-66 Closed; 67-68 All; 69-73 All; 74-86 All; 87-94 All; All Modifieds; and All Special Productions.

Entrants can save money by registering early. Before June 1st, Show cars can register for \$12.00 (\$15.00 day of show), with each additional car registering for \$5.00. Entrants to the car corral can register for \$15.00 (day of show only). Vendors for the swap meet can register for \$15.00 by June 1st (\$25.00 day of show).

Pre-registered cars also receive a free Southern Nationals Calendar and a picture of their car taken on the day of the show.

To get to the show site, take I-24 south of Nashville toward Chattanooga. Exit at Highway 231 and go North (left) to the square. From the square, go east on Main Street to the show site-Central Middle School.
