A work of beauty and excellence is how I have to describe this month's 1967 Fastback. The powerplant is a completely rebuilt 289 4v V8 with a larger cam, which is a hydrolic version of the 289 HiPo cam. It also has a duel point distributor.

As for the body work, which was done by Roger Wilson of Smithville, to go into detail, I was told it would be easier to list what wasn't replaced. The paint work was done by Randy Shedd of S&S Auto Restoration of Smithville.

The Elliotts acquired this pony in 1987 in pretty rough shape and have done a major portion of the work, with the exception of the machine work. John Baker in Franklin did that part.

Since completing the restoration in September of this year, it has taken 3 trophies. A Gold trophy in Oak Ridge, 1st place in our Cool Spring show and 3rd place in The All Car show in Franklin. Vernon & Doris can be proud of the job done on this month' pony.

## THE AUSSIE REPORT

Hi Fellow Mustangers,

Its been 2 months since Jan & I returned home from Nashville after the Cool Springs Mall Show - it still seems like yesterday as we have such vivid memories of the friendly people we met and the fabulous cars we saw.

Many thanks to our good friend Jim Chism for his hospitality and guided tour of Nashville, Al & Lynne Cole, Ron & Susan Sullivan, Mark & Jane Craig, Jo & Margy Spivey, DeWayne Scruggs for also making us welcome. Being an avid toy & memorabilia collector my bags were bulging when we got home. Jan thanks Bud Morton for his gift of the native American arrow he made for us which we were able to get home without any damage.

The New South Wales branch of The Mustang Owners Club of Australia is based in Sydney and has 320 members as at 1st October, 1995. Cars number about 380, although quite a few of these cars are not registered for road use as they are still left hand drive and are awaiting conversion to right hand drive for use on our roads. Conversion to right hand drive entails a mirror reversed dash and fire wall, new steering box, drag link, idler arm, disc brakes etc and costs about \$4,500us.

Our Club has a monthly run, drive-in nights, joint runs with other car clubs, Show & Shines and a National Concourse in a different State each Easter.

We are just coming into Summer down here and the Show Season has just started. Our annual Club Show & Shine, organised by our Southern Area members about 60 miles south of Sydney, was held on 22nd October and BOY DID IT RAIN!! 63 Mustangs turned out (110 last year on a fine day) but everyone still had a good time and we were fortunate to collect 1st Place in '74-'95 Class with our '88GT for the second year running.

Our next big Show is the All American Day, which our Club organises and attracts over 400 American cars on the 28th January. We usually donate between \$2,000 - \$3,000 to The Childrens Leukaemia Foundation from proceeds of this Show. I will keep you informed on this and future events "DOWN UNDER".

The Mustang hobby is thriving and Mustangers on both sides of the World all have a wonderful comraderie.

We wish everyone at Music City a Happy and Safe Christmas and a Prosperous New Year.
