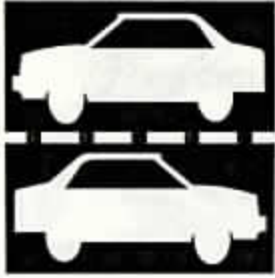

How about a "Stang that makes it to just about all the shows. It's a black beauty that really shines. We have a fine example of such shine from a picture that ran in our March newsletter. The car has a nickname that matches its black coat, "Midnight."

This '66 GT has a motor that packs plenty of horse. To be exact a 289 that has 271 serious horsepower. The engine work was done by Ronny Hoffman. The engine also has the same intake as the Shelby (Ford Production). The rear-end has a 3:50 to 1 gear ratio which probably helps it get of the line in a hurry.

As for the interior and exterior we will find some more goodies. The car rides on Koni shocks and has '65 style steel wheels. It also has a hood scoop. A new exhaust system provides a better sound that won't wake up the neighborhood. On the inside the driver's palms are greeted with a '65 Shelby Walnut Steering wheel.

The history of the car is quite interesting. Midnight was originally sold as a special order car delivered to Newark, N.J. It was probably at one time a drag or race car. It has plugged oil holes where there was once an oil cooler. The Sanford's bought the car from club member Joe Spivey in April '94.

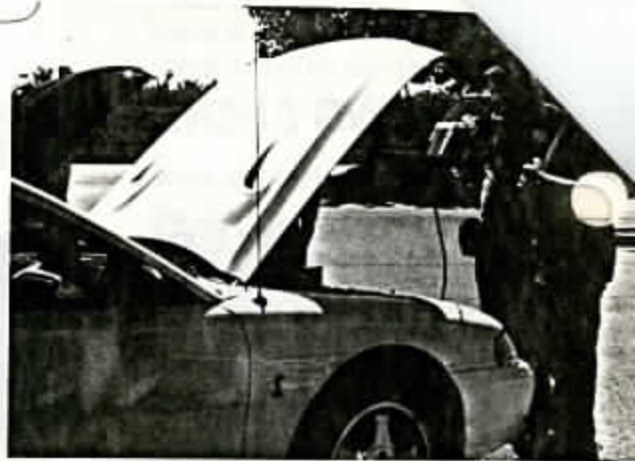
