We start off a new year for Pony of the Month with a beautiful example of workmanship with the Light Pewter Metallic 73 Mach 1 owned by Rob Parsons. The powerplant used to propel this Mustang is a 351 C that could pass for brand new. Backing it up is a FMX automatic transmission.

Most all of the restoration work, with the help of his father, Bill Parsons, and his father-in-law, Glen Jackson, was done by Rob. This includes some extensive body work, replacing the trunk bed, both quarter panels and both floor pans

The car's history shows it was originally sold at a Ford dealer in Gainsboro, not to far from Rob's home in Lebanon, where he purchased it in 1984.

Rob, a member of The Music City Mustang Club since 1993 has done alot of quality work to get it into it's trophy winning shape. The trophy collection included two 1st, one 2nd and one 3rd place. The car is entered in the Nashville AutoFest this month with intentions of adding to his trophy collection.
