#### Soft Pretzels

Her is my recipe for soft pretzels. It comes from the Pennsylvania Dutch Country.

1 pkg yeast  
3/4 C warm Water  
1/4 tsp salt  
2 1/2 C all purpose flour

Dissolve yeast in warm water. Add salt and flour. Knead well. Let rise 15 min. roll dough and shape into pretzel form. Dip in Soda solution then sprinkle with course ground salt.

#### Soda Solution

1/4 C water  
1 tsp soda

Bake at 400 for 20 minutes. Brush with butter when out of the oven.





## HOW TO CHANGE YOUR OIL

Following is a provocative article from an unknown author.

### WOMEN

1. Pull up to Jiffy Lube when the mileage reaches 3000 since the last oil change.

15. Install new oil filter making sure to apply thin coat of clean oil to gasket first.
16. Dump first quart of fresh oil into engine.
17. Remember drain plug removed in step 8.
18. Hurry to find drain plug in drain pan.
19. Hurry to replace drain plug before the whole quart of fresh oil drains onto the floor.
20. Slip with wrench and bang knuckles on frame.
21. Bang head on floor board in reaction.
22. Begin cussing fit.
23. Throw wrench.
24. Cuss for additional 10 minutes because wrench hit Miss December 1999.
25. Clean up; apply Band-Aid to knuckle.
26. Dump in additional 4 quarts of oil.
27. Lower car from jack stands.
28. Accidentally crush one of the jack stands.
29. Move car back to apply more oil lift (AKA kitty litter) to fresh oil spilled during step 16.
30. Drive car.
