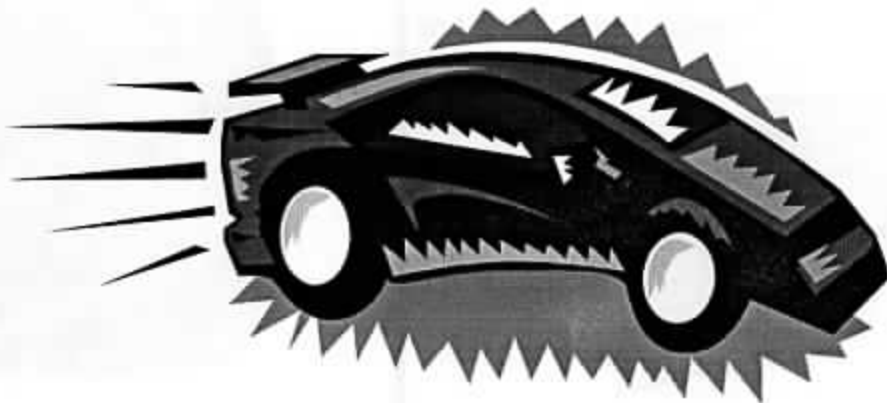

RED VELVET CAKE

|-----------------------------------|-----------------|
| 1/2 c. Shortening                 | 1 c. Buttermilk |
| 1 1/2 c. Sugar                    | 1 tsp. Vanilla  |
| 2 Eggs                            | 2 1/4 c. Flour  |
| 2 Tbsp. Coca                      | 1 tsp. Soda     |
| 1 tsp. Salt                       | 1 tsp. Vinegar  |
| 2 oz. Red Food Coloring (1/4 cup) |                 |

Cream shortening, sugar and eggs. Make paste of coloring and coca and add to mixture. Add buttermilk with salt alternately with flour and vanilla. Lastly add soda and vinegar.

Bake at 350 degrees for 30 minutes. Cool. Use 2-9" Pans.

FROSTING

| 3 Tbsp. Flour | 1 c. Sugar     |
| 1 c. Milk     | 1 tsp. Vanilla |
| 1 c. butter   |                |

Cook flour and milk mixture until thick. Cool. Cream butter and sugar until fluffy. Add vanilla. Blend this mixture into the cooled flour and milk. Frost Cake.
