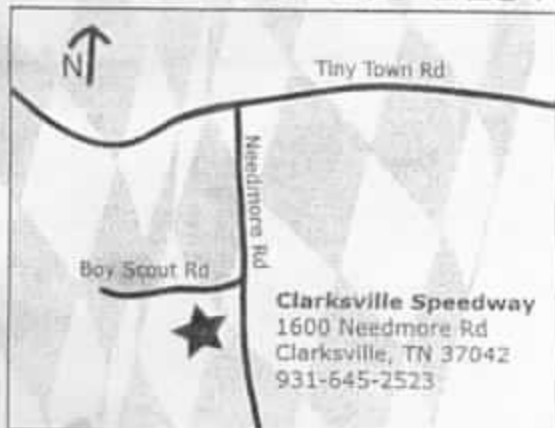

## TECH SECTION-DRAG RACING

If you've never drag raced your Mustang or have never had the opportunity to, then here is a crash course in how it's done. I'll try to make it as simple as possible because it really is this simple. I will say that over the past few years I have never broken my car drag racing. My wife broke my car drag racing. Now that that's out of the way I'll get to the basics.

When you arrive at the strip, just say you want to race. The fee is usually only a few bucks more than the spectator fee. The person will give you a tech card and direct you on where to get your car tech inspected. The tech inspector will write your new car number on the windows of your car. After tech inspection, find you a place to pit your car and remove all the daily junk from the car. (i.e., floor mats, tire iron, coffee cups, fuzzy dice on the mirror). Park next to someone who looks like they know what they are doing, and ask some questions. More than likely anyone who you park next to will know more about racing than you do, so don't be shy.

When the announcer calls your class (i.e., street, modified, power adder) he will also direct you as to which lane to stage in. Then you wait your turn to run down the track. This is the time that your adrenaline starts to increase and you feel for the first time why so many people drag race. Drag racing is an adrenaline addiction that once you are addicted you can't get enough. There is always a man that directs you by hand signals to the lane that you will race in. You can do a burnout if you wish. If you decide to do a burnout, the man will signal when your tires have gotten heated up and waive you forward. Most street tires will not benefit from a big honking burnout, but it looks good for the crowd.

Now is the time to stage along side the car that you are going to annihilate. Just pull up to the start line slowly until your front tires trip the pre stage light (top amber light on the light tree). Then move forward and trip the full stage light (lower amber light on the light tree). Both amber lights at the top of the tree signify that you are fully staged and ready to race. When both cars have fully staged the lights will start to drop from top to bottom. **DON'T FORGET TO GO ON GREEN, DRIVE IT LIKE YOU STOLE IT ALL THE WAY TILL YOU PASS THROUGH THE BIG TIME BOARDS.** Slow down, take a deep breath and get your time slip from the man at the guard shack at the end of the track. **NOW GET BACK IN LINE AND DO IT AGAIN. IT'S THAT EASY!!**

### Some tips:

- Wear your seat belt
- Roll up your windows,
- Helmet is mandatory at times 8.50 or faster in the 1/8th mile,
- Make sure you have plenty of gas in the tank,
- White time slips (you won),
- Yellow time slips (you lost),
- Yellow time slips blow.

Just remember that there is almost always someone at the strip that is slower than you and you may have to make a few passes down the track to find out who it is. Have fun!!!
