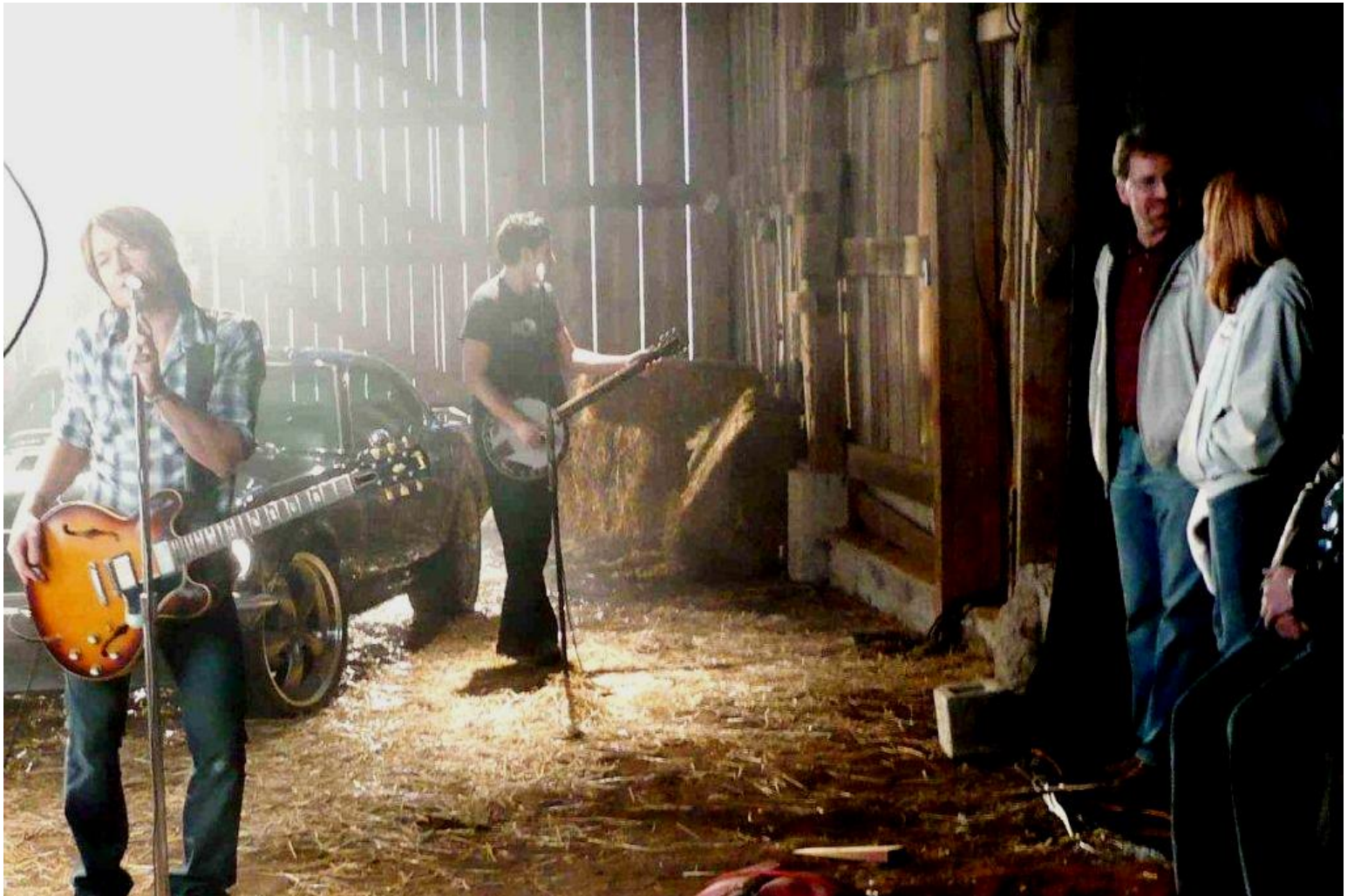

Here are some pictures and some comments regarding our '69 mustang participating in the latest Keith Urban video, which has just gone to #1 in the US.

The video was shot on Monday 12/8 in:

1. Watertown - at "Jakes Garage" which is in the lyrics of the song where the mechanic borrows his uncle Jake's mustang to go ask his girl to marry him. Then they shot several wedding scenes as the car drove away with the cans dragging behind the car with the "Just Married" sign.

Then we went to Lebanon:

1. Diner - 70's scene - for the wedding proposal, where the mechanic pulls up and proposes to his girl who is working at the diner.
2. House 1 - 80's scene - this is where the car had to be traded for the station wagon, because the married couple started having kids and the sports car had to go. The entire crew thought the car should stay and something else should have to go??? Ha, ha.
3. House 2 - 60's scene - this is where the boyfriend has asked his girl to sneak out of the house for a ride, also in the lyrics of the song.

Our 69 was used exclusively for all the scenes.

On Tuesday 12/9, was the band shoot at a tobacco barn in Springhill.

This is where we saw Keith's '69 mustang. We unloaded them side by side; it was amazing. The cars looked so similar; his had several mods. Unfortunately, the weather turned terrible, so his went in the barn, and mine back in the car hauler.

Keith's car was placed in the barn and the band was staged around it. Here they shot several takes of Keith and the band members using various lenses.

Nish and I stood only 10 feet away from Keith while he was singing for the whole day. It was really cool. After each take, David and I dusted Keith's car (remember barn, dirt floor, hay, etc.). At the end of the day, we got to meet him. He had already heard of our car being used the previous day, and how great the car looked. He was very nice (Nish says HOT, but I can't say that). I told him that we needed to get the two cars together and take them for a run; he laughed and agreed. He was on a time crunch, so we asked for a quick picture; he grabbed us both, put his arms around us and said sure. You may notice that Nish is smiling so much more than I am, I wonder why.... As he was leaving the barn and heading to his RV, he got a quick chance to see our car (I had unloaded it so he could get a quick glance). He just kept saying "Sweet Thing" over and over about our car. He shook my hand, thanked us again, and had to go...

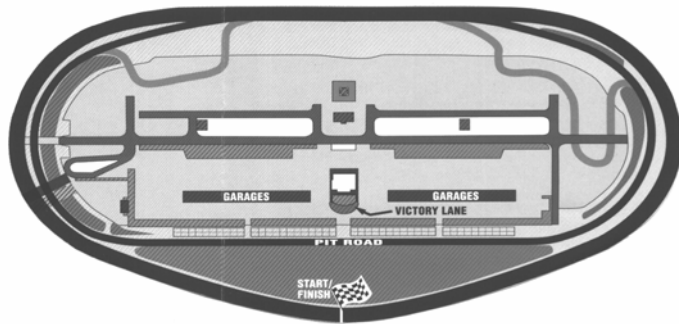
